Parks & Rec Chair Report:

- Not present.
- Goose Issue Update: BPRD implementing a program encouraging Canada geese to migrate out of the area prior to molting in June. The Humane Society of the United States and the Geese Peace organization indicates that using measures of: 1) herding geese with USDA Wildlife Services trained dogs, 2) harassment by staff, with remote control boats, noise makers and lasers, 3) oiling eggs, or 4) using repellents where feasible, could all provide resolve. In May, the district and Wildlife Services will evaluate efforts and determine whether it will be necessary to resort to physically removing geese from the parks. If it is determined that removal is necessary, removal would take place in June when geese are flightless during the molt. Core resident geese, which are highly acclimated to our river parks, will be very difficult, if not impossible to force into a molt migration.

2030 Vision Report:
